

November 28th.2010 CATALONIA has voted! The party CIU “Convergencia i Unio” is a christian democratic party alliance led by Artur Mas.

The result of the election was a clear success by the CIU, 62 of the 135 seats in the parliament of Catalonia went to the CIU. The absolute majority requires 68 seats. The CIU is against the demarcation und application of the costal law. If the CIU sticks to the promise, made to the APA before the election, it could mean to Sta. Margarita, Empuriabrava and Sabanell (Blanes) a positive change. Well lets see what happens nevertheless our endeavours have to go on.

A ray of hope is visible. Before the election, the CIU represented by “Sra. Elena Rivera, Sra.
