Why a further round of letters to Brussels? The basic idea is, only if the European Union- Charter is converted into national Spanish law, do we have legal security for private property in Spain!!

As long as the Spanish constitution, §33, is not changed any government of Spain can think of a new law and the trouble starts all over!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

The legal situation is quite simple, Spain has signed and ratified the Lisbon-Treaty and thereby legally recognized the EU- Charter!

The report the European Commissioner V. Reding on the 2.2.2011 gave to the Petitions committee is short and concise and declares according to the understanding of a legal layman:
The member states, in secret, apparently agreed to limit the application rights of §51 very narrowly! Everything under the magic word of the subsidiarity principle (assistance to do it yourself) in other words they are confident that each member state will convert the EU- Charter into national law! Does anybody believe that, does anybody know of such actions in Spain?

According to my information, no great drive exists in the EU to demand from Spain that it fulfils its contract obligations.
For this reason we must again demand from our MEP to be active again in the European Parliament and that is what we want to achieve with our letters.
